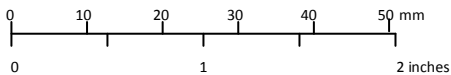


A GUIDE TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Please read carefully all instructions to make measurements as accurate as possible

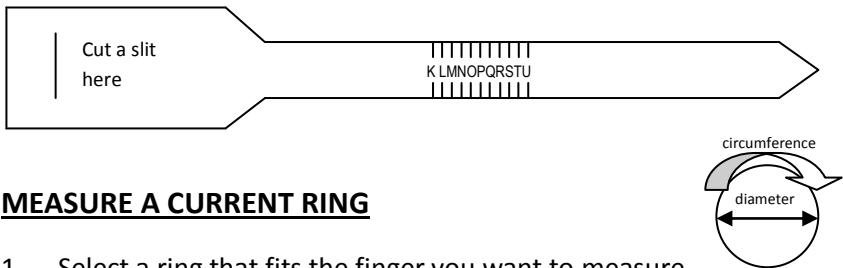
Check your printed paper size with a ruler



1. Print this PDF at 100% by ensuring that page scaling is set to 'NONE' or 'NO SCALING' on your print dialog box.
2. Measure the bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 5 cm or 2 inches long.

MEASURE YOUR FINGER SIZE

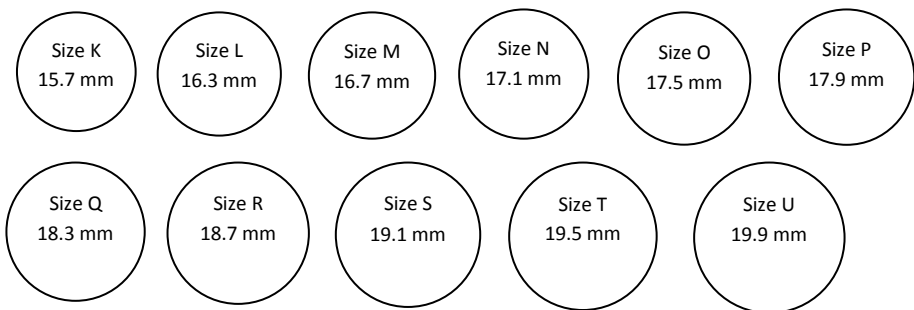
1. Carefully cut out the ring sizer below and cut a slit as indicated.
2. Slide the pointed end through the slit to make a loop with the letters facing out.
3. Move the sizer over your finger to the largest part of your finger, which is usually your knuckle, and pull tightly to get a snug fit.
4. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size for that finger.



Remember that temperature and humidity affect your finger size, so measure at room temperature.

MEASURE A CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that fits the finger you want to measure.
2. Place the ring over the circles below. The inner edge of the ring should match the outside of the circle.
3. Find the best match and this is your ring size. If slightly uncertain, choose the bigger size.



If you want a wide band ring, get one size bigger.

If in doubt or in between sizes, go for the bigger size.
